Answer: CR123 batteries are 3-volt lithium batteries, often used in cameras, rangefinders, crosshairs, tactical flashlights. Lithium cells have a large capacity, they are resistant to temperatures from -55 to +70

degrees Celsius, and they have a very long life - up to 15 years of usability (at room temperature). Yes, there are available batteries on the market (RCR-123 symbol, they require a dedicated charger).
