



Dark gray lunar filter in the luminaire 1.25 inches. It lets 13 percent of the light from the falling beam. The dark gray filter is suitable for most astronomical telescopes, ranging from small 70mm refractors to large 300 millimeter Newtons. It greatly improves the contrast when observing our natural satellite, especially in the near full phase. Connection of ALL astronomical filters with the exception of solar film filters (which are filters for the lens) is accomplished by screwing the filter into the frame of the eyepiece from the opposite side than applying the eye (ie from the side that we put in the eyepiece extractor) . The filters can be additionally connected with each other, because they have threads on both sides of the luminaire.
